All leagues are two-person team, individual match play, with handicap. One point per player match per hole and a one or two point award per match for net medal score.

Green fees for league play are included in your membership. Non-member league players must pay: \$22/night (which includes green fees + cart). May pay \$300 in advance for the season (minimum 16 weeks of golf and covers any substitute.) Expect an additional league fee of \$25 to \$40 (varies with league) to cover weekly prizes, annual awards and end of year banquet.

Leagues commence 2nd week of May. Please be sure the pro-shop or league coordinator knows you intend to play by May 7th. For info or sign up contact the Pro Shop: 315-287-2130.

WEEKLY EVENTS (No sign ups req'd ahead - just show up. Open to member and non-members.)

Monday: Co-Ed Night, tees off @ 5:30 PM –everyone welcome. Starts 1st week of June.

Co-Ed golf is a fun, social activity. Format is modified alternate shot: Both team members tee off, a drive is selected and from that point one ball is in play. There are many play themes interjected throughout the season to lighten the atmosphere and add variety. Non-member couples pay \$10 per team for golf and cart rental. All teams pay \$5 per night to cover prizes. Optional dinner follows golf: typically \$8 to \$10 per person.

Tuesday: Ladies golf get together 9:30 am. Start date weather dependent. Coordinator: Bosh Sigourney

An informal weekly gathering. Non-members pay regular green fees. Lunch typically follows golf.

Wednesday: Senior Tee Golf. 9:30 a.m. open to all (men and women, members and non-members). Senior tees are used. No pre-sign up is required. \$5. Start date weather dependent. Coordinator : Dan Caruso

“Senior Tee Golf” is a great way to meet fellow members who you don't normally play with. A variety of individual and ad-hoc team formats are employed. Weekly prizes are awarded from the \$5 entry fee. Non-members pay walking green fee. The event mixes “young” men, senior men and women. A Wednesday handicap is developed as you participate.
